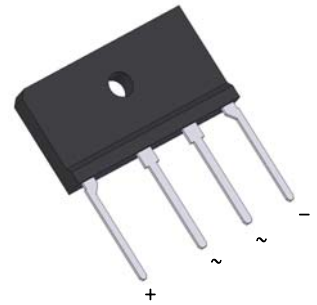

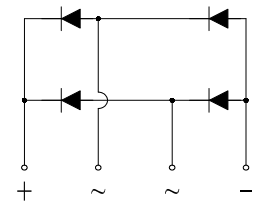

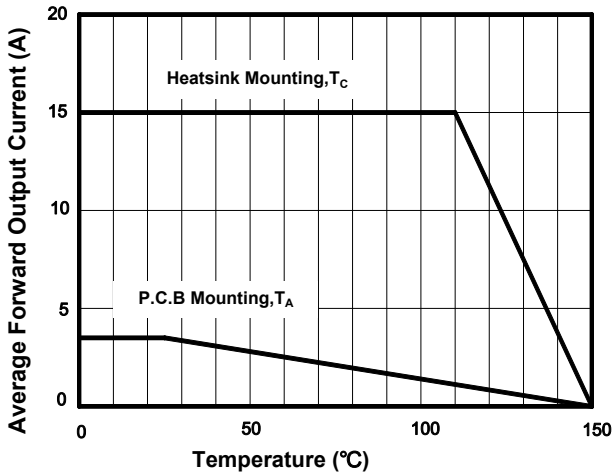


Figure 1. Derating Curve Output Rectified Current

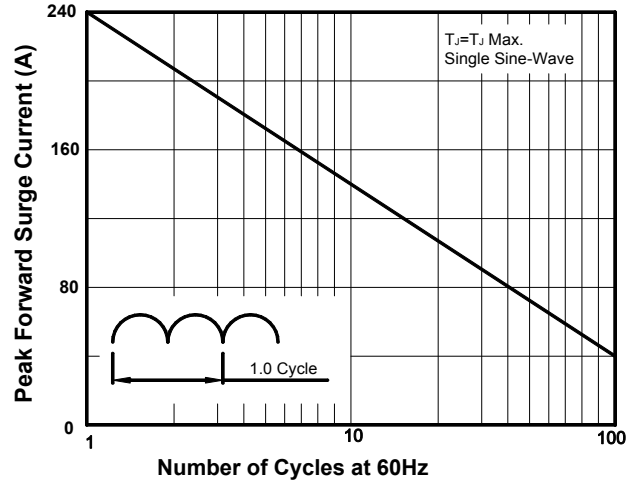


Figure 2. Maximum Non-Repetitive Peak Forward Surge Current per Diode

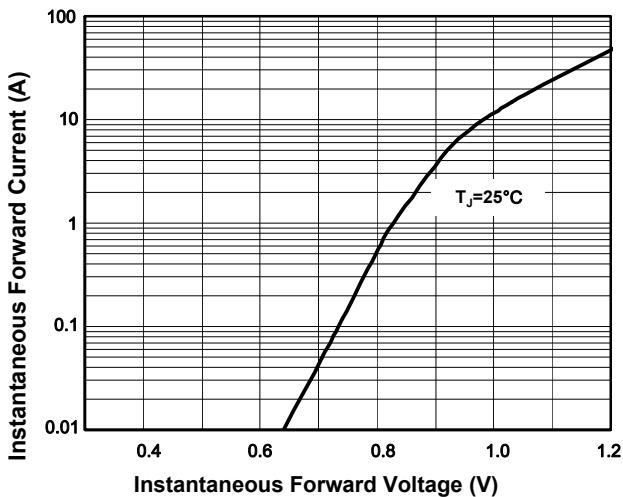


Figure 3. Typical Forward Characteristics Per Diode

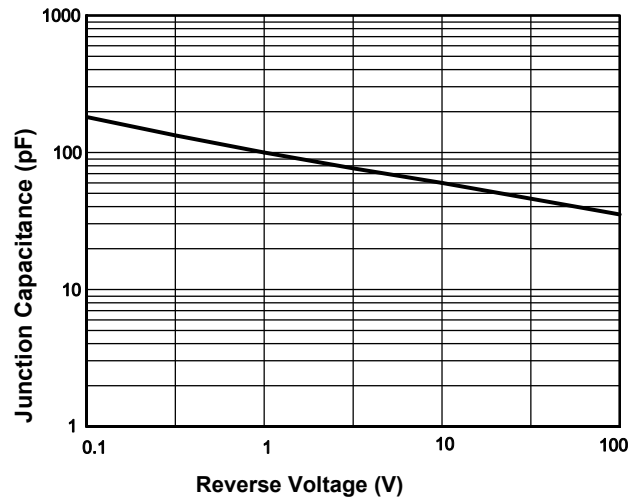


Figure 4. Typical Junction Capacitance Per Diode

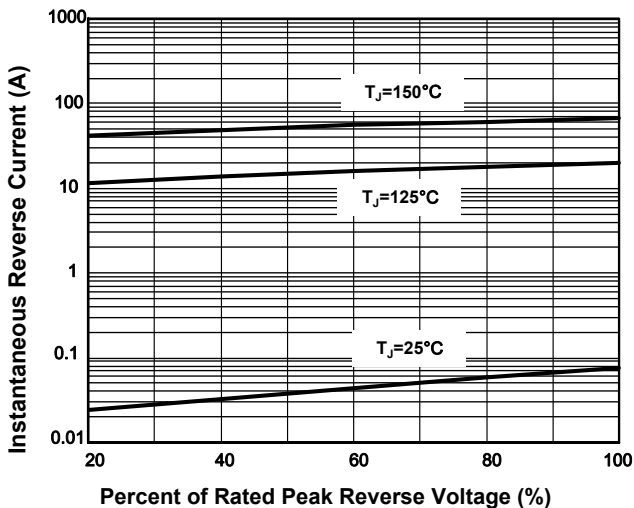


Figure 5. Typical Reverse Characteristics Per Diode
